SEAKAYAK DECEPTION PASS

Deception Pass is legendary for its powerful currents, which sometimes form whirlpools amid the rocks along the cliff-ringed channel. Although experienced paddlers sometimes head into the pass specifically to work on their current handling skills, other paddlers will want to stay clear of the pass except at slack tide. However there are nearby paddle destinations that are fun and don't include the sort of challenging currents found directly in the pass. These range from paddles that are as easy as Cranberry Lake a two and a half mile paddle in land locked fresh water. There is also reasonable paddling in Cornet Bay and Bowman Bay. Both of these are out of the currents, and provides some fascinating shoreline to explore. However for those intermediate to expert paddlers who want to check Deception Pass off of their bucket list we will be at the pass area during slack tide. A worthy objective for these intrepid paddlers might be to paddle through Deception Pass and back through Canoe Pass, encircling the central Island. Provided: transport (rental boats are available).
