GRAND RIDGE DAY HIKE

There are few places in the world where you feel more poised between sea and sky than you do along this 6,000 foot high trail. This is the highest section of trail in this region, above tree line for almost its entirety. Can you say views? Balanced on a knife-edge ridge for much of the hike, you look off to the north and see Victoria, the Canadian Cascades. and Mt Baker. At your feet lie the Strait of Juan de Fuca the towns of Port Angeles and Sequim, and the lovely Dungeness Spit. Look the other way and you are treated to views of Grand Valley with its string of lakes, and the numerous snowcaped peaks of the Olympic interior, including the glacier- laden volcanic Mount Olympus. Bring plenty to drink as there is no water or shade to be had on this hike, just wide open views.

You can hike as short or as long as you like on the ridge depending on your energy level. The first objective, Maiden Peak, is only a three mile round trip. Elk Mountain on the other hand, would be a 14 mile day. The night before the trip we will be staying in Port Angeles so that we can get an early start on the trail. Saturday will be a warm up hike. Provided: transit, lodging, ferry. Dates 8/23-24 cost \$135
