HUCKLEBERRY HIKE

One of the best parts of the fall season is huckleberry muffins, much more flavorful than the traditional blueberries that they would replace, and yet not so sweet. There are a couple favorite spots we will go for either red or evergreen (blue) huckleberries, depending on which is ripe. Along with the berry picking will be a day hike to photograph and view the beautiful fall foliage of this time of year. Valhalla Ridge accesses fields of low growing mountain blueberries, exceptionally prolific in the fall season, and offers beautiful views of lakes and ridges for the easily distracted. Red huckleberries are especially good on the top of Tonga Ridge this time of year, with its southern exposure and somewhat lower elevation the bushes grow tall and full.
