3 DAY SKI TRAVERSE DEER PARK TO HURRICANE RIDGE

The Olympic Mountains have gotten bad press in the world of cross country skiing. Stories abound of terrific winter storms and steep terrain. Put those stories to rest by visiting Hurricane Ridge, the range's most popular ski area. Friday we will ski out from Deer Park perhaps the range's second most popular destination during the summer. This first day will carry us well out onto the connector ridge toward our eventual destination and the second pickup car at Hurricane Ridge. After camping out for our first night the early risers will get some turns in before breakfast and breaking camp mid morning for our second camp. This ridge top has relatively little variation in elevation but offers truly remarkable runs down off of it into the valleys below. Our last day will probably include a ski tour down to Whiskey Bend from Hurricane Ridge. The tour down to Whiskey Bend leads past the gleaming slopes and stunning scenery that in 1982 led the United Nations to designate Olympic National Park as a World Heritage Park.
