MAINE & NEW HAMPSHIRE

With its white church steeples and village greens ringed by a dozen historic buildings, the western Maine town of Bethel simply oozes New England charm and exudes a profound sense of belonging. But Bethel represents far more than picture postcard New England. This is the real thing, a place where cross country ski enthusiasts feel they belong during the winter season. The area's allure pulls in thousands of Nordic skiers each season. Many drive hundreds of miles and some come even farther (that would be us). There's a solid reason why: Bethel is the number one Nordic destination in Maine. Three excellent touring centers, boasting a total of 130 kilometers of machine manicured trails, are located within a few miles of town - one is in the village itself -and the skiing lifestyle suffuses the region. In keeping with Bethel's homey, old fashioned gestalt, be warned not to look for any national fast food chain restaurants here as they have kept them and Walmart at bay so far. Some of the best known cross-country ski trail systems in new england await us in both bethel and nearby new hampshire (only an hour away).

Our ski destinations include Carters XC Ski Center 50K, the Bethel Inn Nordic Center a local resort since 1913, Sunday River Nordic featuring cozy trail side lodging, and Great Glen trails located on the skirts of Mt.
