Early this year a we got a group together to meet with the Mt. Rainier Park Superintendent to try and get a new snowpark approved at the Sunrise turn off but they weren't quite ready to approve the site this year. However they suggested the Mowich Lake side of the park as an alternative. So we are going to check out the skiing over at that entrance. Here is the description. In the northwest corner of Mt. Rainier is the least used entrance to the national park. Due to the high elevation of this road it gets snowed in early in the ski season. This is our destination for this year's early season nordic trip. The road is a fairly moderate slope (about 7% grade) and goes for miles up into the park. Views of Mt. Rainier are frequent along the upper stretch of road. I will be keeping an eye on Cayuse Pass though and if we can make it up to the pass before closure this will be the priority.
