PRESIDENTS' DAY IN CENTRAL OR.

Mt. Bachelor is Oregon's premier resort destination for Nordic skiers and for downhill skiing alike. Skiers come from around the world to enjoy its reliable relatively dry snow, sunshine, and long season. The trails here and in the adjacent Dutchmans Flat have some fine views of Mt. Bachelor and the South sister but the views are not the main attraction. Cross country and downhill skiers both come for the extremely well groomed trails, for the nordic crowd these are some of the best groomed that can be found anywhere in the nation. Adjoining the commercial nordic center are some wonderful snowshoe trails leading off into the Three Sisters Wilderness as far as you wish to wander. Then for the hard-core there is the South Sister to climb and telemark, or tele the ski area's acres of lift served slopes. The groomed track system has 50km of trails of all difficulties, the tour ski area has 30km of ungroomed also for any ability, and the area has 3,600 acres under lift service. Everything is included for this trip, so all you need is your touring gear and personal items. Lodging, three meals a day, and transportation for the three day trip are all part of the package. Dress comfortably for the trip down to Oregon. Monday will be spent at Mt. Hood, overlooking the Columbia River, and skiing their trails. Provided: transit, lodging, meals.
