SUGARBUSH TRAIL MINNESOTA

Driving up the north shore of Lake Superior, you could easily think you'd been transported to coastal Maine. This scenic route sets the stage for an idyllic journey to one of the most enjoyable upper Midwest skiing experiences there is. While the trails of the north shore of the great lakes have been featured in many ski magazines, the Sugarbush Trail system is one of the best. It has been called a "Hidden Gem" by Cross Country Skier, little Norway by locals, and other glowing descriptive titles. The Sugarbush Trail is actually a system of trails, all within the Superior National Forest. Trail heads like Moose Fence, Oberg Mt. and Briton Peak provide access to this 65 km trail network where easy to intermediate trails connect to interior trails of greater difficulty. The trail system is made possible by a partnership between the trail association and the local Forest. The association budgets over \$24,000 a year for grooming the network. Despite the care put into trail maintenance, a sense of remote wilderness pervades the terrain, because that is pretty much what it is. However a new trail connector being completed this year provides access to the Cascade Trails, 20km of easy skiing on the golf course and the local nordic center. From here there is access to yet another 51 km of trails. We will be staying in nearby Tofte with access to plenty of restaurants and a warm comfortable bed that will feel so good after a great day of tour skiing and nature photography.
